# **Have Your Say on Crohn's & Colitis Research**

Do you have unanswered questions about your Crohn's disease or ulcerative colitis, also known as inflammatory bowel disease (IBD)? Tell us what you think and help change lives of people living with IBD.

# Why we need your help

Crohn's & Colitis Australia (CCA) working with the James Lind Alliance are looking for the Top 10 research priorities of people with IBD, carers and healthcare professionals. Your questions can help us find important areas to research in order to improve the healthcare and wellbeing of Australians affected by IBD. We are interested in giving you a louder voice in research. We want ideas and thoughts from people with different experiences and backgrounds.

This survey is the first step in collecting your questions about IBD, that will be followed by a second survey to prioritise the questions. The final list of Top 10 unanswered research questions will be shared with researchers and research funders to encourage them to focus on the most urgent and relevant needs of people living with IBD.

## What do we mean by unanswered questions?

An unanswered question is any uncertainty related to IBD that you think could benefit from research. You do not need to know whether or not the question is actually unanswered. It is enough to write a short sentence about something that is important to you, but for which you haven't been able to find an answer. We will then turn your responses into research questions.

After your questions are collected, we will check them against published research to see if they have been answered. The most important thing is to draw on your personal experience of IBD. Whilst we acknowledge the importance of finding a cause and cure for IBD, we are particularly interested in questions about prevention (limited to lifestyle factors), treatment, symptoms, diagnosis and living with IBD.

Please remember, these are just examples and should not limit you.

- 3. What questions or concerns about the **symptoms** or **diagnosis** of IBD would you like to see answered by research?
- 4. What questions or concerns about **living with IBD** would you like to see answered by research?
