

Sexual Violence JLA Priority Setting Partnership: Workshop Safety Frequently Asked Questions

1. What support will be available during and after the workshop?

There will be a quiet room available to join should you find any topics or conversations distressing. This will be in the form of a separate Zoom call that can be joined at any time where a member of the team will be available to talk to you.

At the end of the workshop, we will provide contact phone numbers and websites for services where you can access support (nationally and locally).

2. Will there be female only groups?

Yes, you will have the option to be in a female-participant-only group. The facilitator of the group will also be female.

3. Will I have to share my personal experience?

You only have to share what you feel comfortable sharing. The main thing is you are able to advocate for the research questions you consider to be priorities and why you consider them to be important.

4. Can I keep my camera off?

Yes of course, if you feel more comfortable that way.

5. Will the session be recorded?

No, there will also be no photography of the event.

6. Can I be confidential in the group e.g. use my first name only?

Yes – first names only are preferred. You are welcome to use a pseudonym if this makes you more comfortable.

7. What confidentiality is there in terms of what is shared in the meeting and what will happen to the information afterwards?

No data besides the Top 10 research priorities will be shared after the workshop. We will tweet that a workshop is happening, but no participants' names or information will be shared.

8. What group agreement is there e.g. respect etc.?

It is JLA policy for ground rules around respect and confidentiality to be set, this will be done at the start of the workshop.
