## James Lind Alliance / Prostate Cancer Priority Setting Partnership.

The James Lind Alliance (JLA) is a project, funded jointly by the National Institute of Health Research and the Medical Research Council.

Their one simple aim is to provide an infrastructure and process to help Patients and Clinicians work together to agree on what are the most important Treatment Uncertainties affecting their particular interest so that future Research / Reviews can be targeted to what they deem has the highest priority.

The <u>Prostate Cancer Research Foundation</u> and the <u>Prostate Cancer Support Federation</u>, supported by the <u>Prostate Cancer Charter for Action</u> have asked the JLA to work though this process with all interested organisations in prostate cancer - hence this letter to you.

Lester Firkins is the independent Chair of the JLA Strategy and Development Group, and his role will be to chair this <u>Priority Setting Partnership (PSP)</u> over the next months, concentrating on ensuring that, as far as possible, the process is fair and free from bias, and most importantly to ensure that Patients and Clinicians do have equal voices and that real Treatment Uncertainties are considered.
